Nauticalia Ferry Shepperton – Weybridge

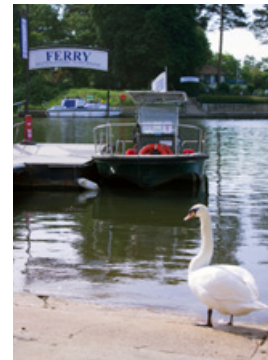


The Nauticalia Ferry continues a service that has operated from this point for around 500 years, and enables people walking or cycling the Thames Path to continue their journey past Shepperton Lock without being diverted by the Wey Navigation. The ferry runs every 15 minutes and you should ring the bell on the quarter hour if coming from the south (Weybridge) side to ensure the ferryman knows you are waiting. The bell on the Weybridge side is located at the bottom of the quayside steps.

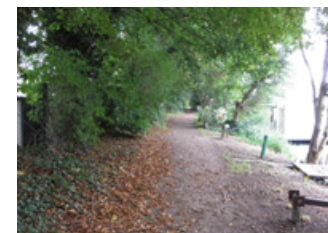

Residential Moorings

Nauticalia own and operate a small number of residential moorings available to let on the River Thames in a glorious countryside location just upstream from Shepperton Lock. They are suitable for navigable vessels or smart purpose-built houseboats up to 5.65m fixed beam, 5.3m air draft (two storeys) and overall length 17m (55ft 9in). Each mooring benefits from: allocated parking; mains water, electricity, and telephone/internet; privately-owned sewage treatment works.
